



REGISTRATION POLICY

1. All delegates below the age of 18 are required to attain complete parental consent to participate in ADMUN 2.4.
2. All delegates attending ADMUN 2.4 will be required to pay a fee. This fee is non-refundable, however, in extenuating circumstances, compensation of funds may be issued with a service charge.
3. Registrations are subject to rejection or placement on a waiting list given the delegate capacity, and/or by the discretion of the Secretary-General.
4. A delegate may only receive their allocation once payment for attendance has been made, either via payment link or the Al Diyafah Parent Portal (exclusive to students studying at ADHS).
5. Delegates are expected to arrive promptly to all committee sessions; be respectful of the executive board, chairs and fellow delegates in all formal and informal sessions.
6. Delegates are required to attend the conference in appropriate business attire, arrival in casual or improper clothing that does not align with the conference's dress code will not be tolerated.
7. Transportation to and from the premises of the conference will not be provided, delegates will, therefore, be required to make any and all arrangements concerning this.
8. Any forms and degrees of harassment, discrimination and/or bullying observed by the secretariat, organizers or other delegates are to be reported to the Secretary General, and by their discretion, disciplinary action may be enacted.
9. Participants and organizers must abide by the United Arab Emirates' Federal Laws, Dubai's national laws and all other rules and regulations enforced and instigated by the Al Diyafah High School.
10. No exceptions will be made, and any breach of protocol may result in suspension from the conference.
